Specialist Leader - Person Specification

Essential

1. Participation on a UCL/IOE First World War Centenary Battlefields Tour, including completion of the online or face-to-face pre-tour programme CPD
2. Evidence that as a consequence you worked with your pupils to set up a successful and enduring post-tour project which impacts upon your local community. (This may be in-progress or completed at the time of application)
3. Qualified teacher status or equivalent professional experience.
4. Evidence of creative, effective and engaging teaching about the First World War to secondary school pupils.
5. Excellent interpersonal skills including the ability to work effectively and co-operatively with others.
6. Excellent communication skills, both written and verbal, for use with a range of audiences e.g. pupils, teachers, community groups etc.

Desirable

7. Some knowledge of developments and scholarship in First World War education.
8. Some knowledge and experience of using digital media to enhance teaching and learning.
9. Experience of co-ordinating wider educational activities with other staff in your own school, or with staff in other schools / local networks / community groups or similar
10. Some evidence of developing innovative and engaging teaching and learning materials.
11. Some evidence of carrying out research into aspects of teaching and learning.
